In His Sermon on the Mount in the Gospel of Matthew (6:19-24), Jesus teaches us "Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. This passage is the focus of our 2018 Stewardship Campaign.

#### The Coachella Valley Rescue Mission

Today our Moment for Ministry features the Coachella Valley Rescue Mission (cvrm.org). Darla Burkett, Executive Director, will provide us with an update on the incredible ministry that we strongly support. The lives of men, women and children are dramatically changed when they come to know the saving grace of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

In addition to the Emergency Overnight Shelter, which houses 75+ clients every night, the Mission serves over 600 meals a day and has over 250 clients in either the Gateway Program which helps them stabilize their lives, find employment and housing and all the support services they need to break the bonds of homelessness, and New Life, which is a year long faith based program that leads people to salvation, housing, jobs, reconciliation with family and friends. This program has over an 83% success rate (which means clients are still sober, employed, in permanent housing and have a strong support system a year after they have graduated from the Program.

Additionally, the Mission serves the local communities with food boxes weekly, the annual back to school back pack distribution and the annual Christmas Gift Day where over 3000 children receive 3 gifts each including bicycles for over 300 children. This past Thursday the Mission had a Ribbon Cutting Ceremony for its new Health To Hope Medical Clinic. This and so much more.

Every year, millions of people like you pack shoeboxes and drop them off at thousands of locations. Another 9,000+ volunteers serve year-round to support the project. Join the faithful servants of Christ who make this happen.



Shoeboxes will be available for you to pick up, take home and fill beginning **October 22 and ending November 12**. Look for our table in the courtyard under the Olive tree. You can also pick up boxes at the church office during the weekdays.

What a great way to be involved from the convenience of your own home!

Packing a shoebox is so much more than just giving a child toys and gifts! In addition to hearing the Gospel before they receive their shoebox gift, children also receive The Greatest Gift, a storybook that shares the message of salvation. With the Apostle John as narrator, the booklet shares 11 Scripture stories and invites children to follow Christ. Children take this home to share with family and friends. It is used in more than 80 languages.

After receiving shoebox gifts, many children are invited back to participate in our discipleship program, The Greatest Journey. Through this 12-lesson course, which includes Bible stories and Scripture memorization, they learn how to follow Christ in their daily lives as they share Him with friends and family.

After completing The Greatest Journey, children attend a graduation celebration and receive a certificate. Most importantly, they are given a Bible that includes the New Testament and selected Old Testament stories along with a dictionary of Biblical terms and a map of Bible lands. Complete with illustrations, it is often the first copy of God's Word the child, or their family, will own.

Family and friends who attend the ceremony hear the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Hearing the Good News and testimonies during their loved one's graduation reinforces the changes they have seen in the students' lives, and their families often come to faith in Christ.



#### FAMILY ROOM AVAILABLE



- ... after the gavel goes down, the handcuffs go on, and your loved one is led away.

- ... after you find a pink slip with your final paycheck.
- ... after your family and friends have heard the story one too many times, but you still need to talk it out.

Stephen Ministers are the "After People." They are ready to come alongside you - or your friends, neighbors, co-workers, or relatives - and provide comfort and support for as long after as needed.
